Response from the Environmental & Planning Group of the Hadleigh Society to the  
'visually verified montages' relating to PLANNING APPLICATION B/16/00760  
received on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2016

These comments are submitted on behalf of the Hadleigh Society, whose objectives are:- *“to protect and enhance Hadleigh’s heritage and environment by supporting and promoting high standards in planning, conservation, regeneration and development of features deemed to be of historical or environmental significance in the town.”*

The Environmental & Planning Group of the Hadleigh Society acknowledge receipt of the 'visually verified montages' relating to Planning Application B/16/00760. These montages have not, however, allayed the concerns of the Society, particularly in relation to the height and siting of the apartment block, nor have they allowed members to change any of the comments submitted in their two previous responses to the initial proposal and the subsequent amendments.
